Q: What is Electronic Contribution?

A: Electronic contribution is an automatic transfer program that allows you to make contributions without writing checks.

Q: What are the advantages of electronic contribution?

A: It saves you time! It simplifies your life! You also help the Campaign for Equal Justice office stabilize its budget and save money.

Q: How is my electronic contribution automatically deducted from my account?

A: Once you authorize the transfer, your specified contribution is electronically transferred directly from your checking, savings, credit or debit card account to the Campaign for Equal Justice account.

Q: When will my contribution be deducted from my account?

A: Monthly payments are generally processed between the 5th and 10th of each month. If you would prefer a different day, please specify your preference on your request form. We can arrange a periodic schedule, or fulfill your pledge in one payment; whatever suits your needs.

Q: If I don't write checks, how do I keep my checkbook balance straight?

A: Since your contribution is made at a pre-established time, you simply record it in your check register on the appropriate date.

Q: Without a canceled check, how can I prove I made my contribution?

A: Your bank statement gives you an itemized list of electronic transfers. It's your proof of contribution. We will also send you a letter confirming your initial pledge amount, and another when your pledge is completed.

Q: Is electronic contribution risky?

A: Electronic contribution is less risky than check contributions. It can't be lost, stolen or destroyed in the mail, and it has an extremely high rate of accuracy.

Q: What if I change bank accounts or credit/debit cards?

A: Notify the Campaign for Equal Justice office and we will provide a new authorization form to complete.

Q: How much does electronic contribution cost?

A: It costs you nothing and saves you time!

Q: What if I try electronic contribution and don't like it?

A: You can cancel your authorization for electronic contribution at any time by notifying us in writing. You can also temporarily suspend payments if necessary, simply by calling our offices.

Q: How do I sign up for electronic contribution?
